**Reef Knot** – Used for joining together two ropes of equal thickness




**Sheet Bend** – For joining together two pieces of rope of unequal thickness (securing a flag to the flag pole)




Figure of Eight – Used for: Preventing a rope running through a block. Commonly used for the sheets of a sailing boat.




## **Sheep Shank** - Used for shortening a rope



**Bowline** - Used for forming a loop which will not slip but can untie easily



## **Round turn** – Used for securing a boat to any object



## **Clove Hitch** - For securing a rope to a pole or similar object
